

16th ANNUAL DGA STUDENT FILM AWARDS



for women and minority Directors

The Directors Guild of America Student Film Awards for African-American, Asian-American, Latino, and Women Directors are designed to honor, encourage, and bring attention to outstanding minority and women students in DGA selected film schools in the Eastern and Western region. The awards bring prizes of \$2500 to the winners in each category.

APPLICATION

- 1. Competing films must have been **completed** in the 2009/2010 school year (September 2009 through August 2010).
- 2. Applicants must be enrolled in or be a recent (within one year) graduate from an accredited post-secondary institution selected by the DGA.
- 3. Applicants must be the Director of the film. No co-director applicants.
- 4. Only films or videos produced as a student project under the supervision of a faculty member are eligible.
- 5. <u>Eligible student films are those in which every major crew position was held by a student.</u> <u>Productions in which a non-student, a professional or a faculty member served as producer, editor, cinematographer, or screenwriter will be disqualified.</u>
- 6. Eligible films are dramas, comedies and documentaries. Animated films, experimental films, commercials and music videos are not eligible. No more than 30% of stock footage may be used in documentary films. All music rights must be obtained prior to submission.
- 7. Students may submit more than one film, but may not submit the same film to more than one group (African-American, Asian-American, Latino or Women). For Example, a woman of color may submit a film to either an ethnic minority category or the womens category or submit films to both categories, as long as it is not the same film.
- 8. Entries must be on DVD and labeled with name, address, phone number and film title. **Please make sure materials** are playable and are in working order.
- 9. <u>Entries should be no longer than 30 minutes in length</u>. Longer films must be cued to the appropriate starting place. Only 30 minutes of each submission will be viewed.
- 10. A supervising faculty member must endorse the applicant's entry form.

11. <u>ENTRY DEADLINE: All submissions must be received at the Directors Guild National Office in Los Angeles</u> by 6:00 PM on Monday, October 4, 2010.

- 12. The winner in each group (African-American, Asian-American, Latino and Women) is awarded \$2,500 by the DGA. A Jury Award (Honorable Mention) may also be awarded in each group. At the discretion of each committee, awards may not be granted.
- 13. Winners must submit their same completed film in its final format for screening at the Awards ceremony. 30 minutes of all Award-winning films will be screened.
- 14. The Awards ceremonies will take place at DGA headquarters in Los Angeles and New York at dates TBD.
- 15. Entries must be submitted to the Directors Guild of America, Attn: 16th Annual Student Film Awards, 7920 Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA 90046. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like your film returned to you.
