(FOR STUDENTS ENTERING FALL, 2011 OR LATER)

The School of Film and Photography offers a Photography minor on a space-available basis. The minor consists of 28 credits. Typically, the minor will require a minimum of 2 1/2 years to complete. Photography minors must meet the same gate eligibility requirements as photography majors, excluding FILM 112. Accepted Photo minors are required to purchase a Mac laptop computer.
