## \*SFP ELECTIVES (AT LEAST 4 COURSES, 12-16 CREDITS):

Any courses offered in the School of Film & Photography including THTR 304, MUST 295, MUST 380 and MUST 382, that are *not* serving to fulfill any requirements listed above. Any of the studies or production courses listed above in excess of the number required in each category can be taken as SFP Electives. This requirement is intended to permit Film and Photography students to explore their individual interests in greater depth in one area or more broadly in both areas.

## \*\*NON-SFP ELECTIVES (AT LEAST 3 COURSES, 9-12 CREDITS):

Includes any courses offered outside the school of Film & Photography that are not serving to fulfill university CORE requirements. This requirement is intended to encourage Film and Photography students to develop an area of knowledge to inform their pursuits as creative artists. Completion of a minor outside of the School of Film and Photography will fulfill this requirement.

Photography Students are *strongly* recommended to take at least one of *ARTZ106RA 2-D Foundations*, *ARTZ 108RA 3-D Foundations*, or *ARTZ 105RA Drawing*, and *ARTH 200IA Art of World Civilization I or ARTH 201IA Art of World Civilization II. These Art History courses may also be taken as Photography Studies electives.*
