The School of Film and Photography offers a Minor in Photography on a space-available basis. The minor consists of 28 credits. Due to the sequential nature of certain photography classes, the minor will require a minimum of 2½ years to complete, and continuation in the minor after the first year will be determined by the gate requirements described below.

Accepted Photography minors are required to purchase a MAC laptop computer upon entrance into the fall semester classes of their second year in the minor.

***PHOTO GATE REQUIREMENTS:**
