Demonstration of an exceptional commitment to pursuing a future as a professional in the area of cinematography.

To Apply:

- 1. Attach a written statement, not to exceed 500 words, describing why you consider yourself deserving of this award, and explaining your professional goals in the cinematography area.
- 2. Attach an unofficial university transcript of all academic work through spring semester 2008.
