THE MAX AND ALICE HUNKE PHOTOGRAPHY SCHOLARSHIP 2012

Four annual financial scholarships are awarded by the Photography Faculty of the School of Film and Photography to two men and two women enrolled as full-time Sophomores, Juniors or Seniors, and are based on proven excellence in the following areas:

Submitted Portfolio – 40%

Academic performance (overall and SFP GPA's) – 20%

Demonstration of Leadership – 10%

Involvement in extra-curricular activities – 10%

Potential to succeed in the field – 20%

The awards are given with the expectation that the money be applied to photographic pursuits. This means that when a student receives the award in the following academic year, they must be enrolled as a full time student (no graduating seniors may apply). The amount of each award will be **\$2000**. Students may receive the Hunke award once only.

To apply, please submit a portfolio of 15-20 prints along with a brief artist statement, and completed application form that describes the accomplishments outlined above as well as both current overall GPA and SFP course GPA. Portfolios must be submitted in a proper portfolio case labeled with your name and contact information. Loose portfolios or those in plastic bags will not be accepted for review.

Application forms are available from faculty and at check out.

Awards will be announced in the fall at the photography kick-off meeting
