

## ***Carl B. Swartz Memorial Scholarship***

A 1978 graduate of Film & TV, Carl B. Swartz distinguished himself as an award-winning sound editor in Hollywood. He died suddenly in 1995 at the age of 38.

**Award Amount: \$500**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

Declared major in Film option with Junior standing (minimum of 60 credits completed) in the Film curriculum in the department.

Full-time undergraduate student with an overall minimum 3.00 GPA on all academic work complete at MSU (or by transfer).

Minimum 3.25 GPA on all required courses completed in the Film option.

Completion of required 100 and 200-level courses in Film, or their equivalent by transfer, by the end of spring semester 2013.

Demonstration of an exceptional commitment to pursuing a future as a professional in the motion picture industry

### **To Apply:**

1. Attach a written statement, not to exceed 500 words, describing why you consider yourself deserving of this award, and explaining your professional goals in the motion picture/television industry.
2. Attach a list of your spring semester 2014 courses.
3. Attach an unofficial university transcript of all academic work through fall semester 2013 available on-line.
4. Include an e-mail or address valid through May 31, 2014.
